Subject: Representation seeking the removal of Shri Bandi Sanjay Kumar from the Union Council of Ministers to ensure a free and fair investigation in the POCSO case involving his son.

Respected Prime Minister Narendra Modi Ji,

I am writing to you to draw your urgent attention to a matter of significant institutional propriety, legal ethics, and public trust concerning the composition of the Union Council of Ministers.

As is already a matter of public record and widely known, a serious First Information Report (FIR) stands registered against the son of the Union Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri Bandi Sanjay Kumar. The charges involve severe offences under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

Given the gravity of a POCSO case involving a minor, the paramount objective of the state must be to guarantee that the ongoing investigation and subsequent judicial proceedings are conducted with absolute independence, transparency, and fairness.


Shri Bandi Sanjay Kumar occupies a highly sensitive portfolio as the Minister of State for Home Affairs, a ministry that carries immense

administrative weight over law enforcement mechanisms. While the legal process will independently determine his son's guilt or innocence, his continued occupation of this specific office creates an unavoidable conflict of interest. For a trial of this nature to be truly free and fair, there must be no perception of institutional asymmetry or potential administrative influence over police procedures, evidence gathering, or witness protection. Public faith in the neutrality of the justice system requires that no shadow of political influence hangs over the case.

To uphold the foundational principles of our constitution and protect the integrity of the ongoing legal process, it is vital to maintain the highest standards of political accountability.

Therefore, I earnestly request you to remove Shri Bandi Sanjay Kumar from his position in the Ministry of Home Affairs until the investigation and trial are fully concluded. Taking this step would reinforce public confidence that institutional integrity and the pursuit of justice for minors remain paramount, above all political considerations.
